

Telescopic Handler Truck (Conversion)

This 2 day course is delivered on client's sites using their truck and is suitable for delegates with a current Counterbalance Fork Lift licence and is recommended at least every three years. This course is a fully accredited ITSSAR approved training course that will enable the attendees to qualify to drive a Telescopic Handler safely & competently.

Course Requirements

- Delegates must hold a current Counterbalance Fork Lift license
- Equipment and site must be compliant with Health & Safety Standards.

- Protective boots* with good grip and protective guarding on the front vamp and instep (complying with EN 345-2)
