Integrated Assessment

Course Content

- Set Up, Use and maintain Ride-On Powered Equipment
- Carry out risk assessment, work safely and minimise environmental damage
- Health & Safety Legislation and environmental good practice
- PPE
- Key features of equipment being used
- Use and Maintain Ride on Powered Equipment
- Control & Instruments relating to Equipment
- Check & Maintain Equipment
- Adjust cutting units.

Course Requirements

You are required to provide your own Machinery, Tools & Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for this training course. You must have a manufacturer's instruction book for the equipment being used for training on the day. All equipment being used for this assessment must comply with the relevant requirements of the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations (PUWER) 1998.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):

- Safety boots
- Ear defenders
- Head protection (essential where a safety cab is not fitted)
- Face/eye protection
- Suitable hand protection worn during operation
- We also recommend you dress appropriately for weather conditions.

On site delivery:

- The course will require a suitable classroom for theoretical delivery
- Please note that the training site and equipment must be compliant with Health and Safety standards.
