- In essence, it covers Plant Protection Technology and it is therefore an important part of the future industry knowledge and skill requirement.

BASIS Certificate in Crop Protection is a pre-requisite of this course.

Aim

- The PPA is an advanced level qualification which builds on knowledge and skills obtained through the BASIS Certificate in Crop Protection IPM course. While this syllabus does not duplicate that of the lower level qualification, candidates should note that it will sometimes be appropriate to draw and build upon knowledge gained at BASIS Certificate level when answering questions.
- For Crop Protection Association members success in the exam fulfils the CPA's Part III training requirement for manufacturer's staff who regularly give advice; it is also the next step for any agronomist, adviser or farm manager who wishes to demonstrate an advanced level of knowledge of Crop Protection Technology.
- The Plant Protection Award is also an essential component for those looking to achieve the BASIS Diploma in Agronomy.
