Outline

- Calibration of a boom sprayer
- A one day training course delivered on the client site
- Followed on a separate day with an approx 2 hour assessment
- The site will need a room for the theory
- A tractor / prime mower and sprayer (compliant with NTST)
- A safe area the calibration practical can be carried out

Each delegate will need:

- Gauntlet Gloves - Min 300mm long - .5mm thick - Nitrile rubber
- Boots - easy to clean and non absorbent
- Coveralls - Min Type 5 or 6 - basic disposable type - use a few times
- Face Shield - for handling the concentrate pesticide
- Calculator for calibration calculation / A means to time seconds and minutes.

Content

- Know the legislative and safety regulations relating to application equipment
- Be able to assess the environmental factors relating to mixing and application
- Be able to read and interpret product information
- Be able to prepare and calibrate the applicator
- Be able to operate the application equipment
- Know how to carry out post-operational procedures
